FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Fasting draws us into solidarity with the sacrifice of Jesus, and invites us to turn to him, who alone can truly satisfy our desires

As Christians, we have the following practices to help us live this out in our own lives, as we are able to, for health reasons or age.

Days of Abstinence - On Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent, those 14 and older are to abstain from eating meat. (Special exception—March 25th see announcement below)

Days of Fast - On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, for those who are able, ages 18 through 59 are permitted to eat one full meatless meal, as well as two smaller meatless meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

SOLEMNITY: ANNUNCIATION OF THE LORD Friday, March 25, 2022

This solemn day falls on a Friday in Lent this year, and Archbishop Hebda has given the faithful, here in the Archdiocese, a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat for this special occasion. Join us for a delicious meal prepared by the Presentation Men's Club this evening in Kenny Hall!
